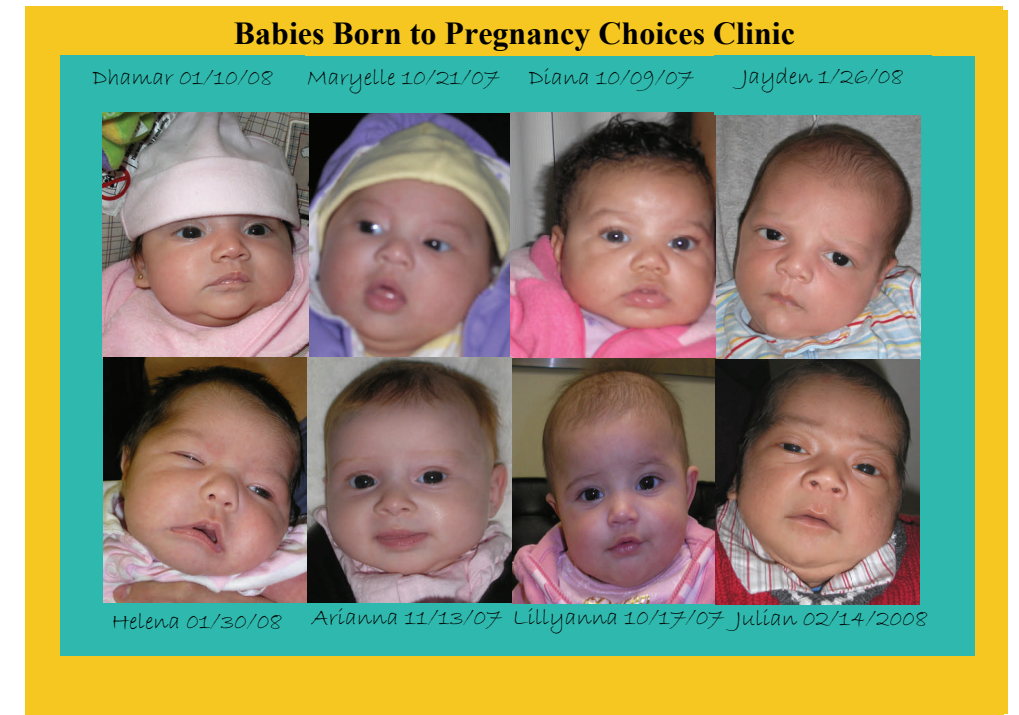

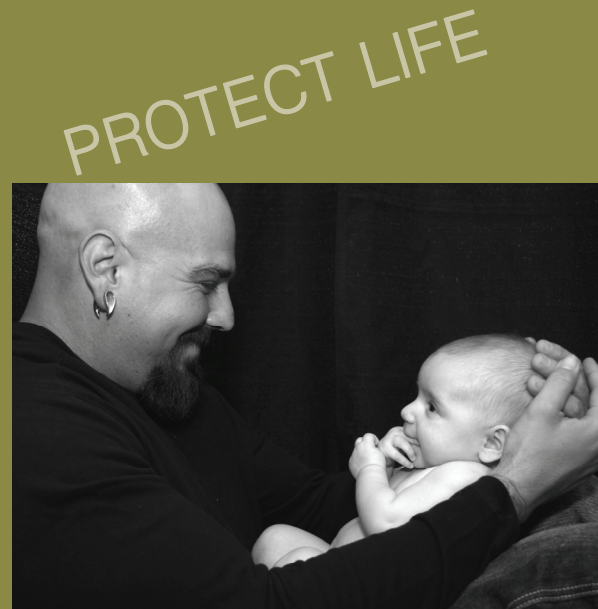

## Stepping 'Outside the Box'



Why do we need to 'step outside the box'? Pregnancy Choices Clinic, like many other non-profits, has experienced a downturn in giving over the last year. As we continue to trust the Lord in the midst of the financial storm our country is going through right now we must be responsible stewards of this ministry. We recently reduced our monthly expenses and will continue to look at more ways to cut costs. What we DON'T want to do is continue to send out 'Help!' letters. How can we continue to bring in the \$35,000/month needed to run this ministry? We are looking at supplementing our regular monthly giving (~\$5800/mo) and three fundraisers, the Walk for Life, fireworks booth and banquet.

### How?

- ♥ By opening a PCC eBay 'store' and event auctions (watch for site in next newsletter)
- ♥ Holding fundraisers that introduce us to more of the people and businesses we serve.
- ♥ And looking for grants

### What are a few of our specific needs over and above our monthly costs?

- ♥ Eight licenses for Office 2007, plus one copy of software
- ♥ Flat panel monitor for older ultrasound machine

- ♥ Provide funds for a financial audit to qualify for grants

A few years ago, a bush pilot visited our church. He talked about his job as a medical missionary. His airplane was a flying ambulance that transported people to the nearest medical center for urgently needed medical care. He flew to places that were so remote that it would take people days to get to medical care. He explained that he was an ordinary guy doing what he was trained to do.

That simple testimony had an enormous impact on my heart. With tears in my eyes, I found myself praying, "Lord, please send me. Send me, an ordinary person to make a difference for You. Use the training You've given me as a nurse to reach those who need you." I pleaded, "Send me. Send me." I've been looking for a medical mission since then.

The job is challenging. It inspires me to pray everyday for God's provisions to do the work. It's a perfect fit. It's a comfortable feeling. It's like being accepted into a new family.
